My name is Bryan Pilkington and I am a Science Specialist and Professional Educator with the Lodi Unified School District in Lodi, California. I live at 13100 Victor Road in Lockeford. I've lived in Lockeford for 20 years and grow hay and raise cattle on my family ranch.

I'm here today to request that the Mokelumne River Water stay within the boundaries of the North San Joaquin Water Conservation District (NSJWCD).

I have many concerns about the management, the plans and the intentions of the North San Joaquin Water Conservation District to put the water to beneficial use within the boundaries the District. The fiscal irresponsibility and lack integrity of the NSJWCD management must be considered with the extension of this permit. The engineer's report and plans that was submitted to the State Water Board has many deficiencies and inaccuracies that would render its implementation ineffective to put the Mokelumne River Water to beneficial use within the boundaries of the NSJWCD. The future plans of the NSJWCD does not include utilizing the majority of the water of the Mokelumne River within the boundaries of the District for the public benefit of the taxpayers who is funding the future projects.

I will discuss in detail the management, the plans and the intentions of the North San Joaquin Water Conservation District to put the water to beneficial use within the boundaries the District at the March 18, 2008 meeting.
