PROPOSED DECISION IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATIONS 30038, 30083, 30160, 30165, 30175, 30178, 30260, 30355, AND 30374: DETERMINATION OF THE LEGAL CLASSIFICATION OF GROUNDWATER IN THE PAUMA AND PALA BASINS OF THE SAN LUIS REY RIVER

The State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) will consider adopting the proposed decision regarding the Pauma and Pala Basins of the San Luis Rey River at its meeting scheduled for **Thursday, October 17, 2002**, in the Coastal Hearing Room, 2nd Floor, in the Cal/EPA Building at 1001 I Street in Sacramento (map enclosed). You will separately receive an agenda for this meeting at least 10 days in advance specifying the exact time and place of the meeting.

At the SWRCB meeting held September 19, 2002, the SWRCB extended the time to comment on the proposed decision for one party, James C. Roberts, Inc. (Roberts), due to a lack of notice. Roberts will have a brief opportunity to comment on the proposed decision at the October 17th SWRCB meeting. Pursuant to instructions by the SWRCB's chair, comments by other parties will not be accepted.

The attached proposed decision makes minor changes to the draft dated August 15, 2002. These changes were made as a result of comments that were received on the previous draft. Changes were made to section 4.0 of the order, "Applicable Law," and to section 5.1, "Separation of Functions". In section 4.0 on p. 6, the word "preponderance" is substituted for the word "weight" of the evidence. In section 5.1 on pp. 10 and 11, clarifying language was substituted regarding the hearing officer excusing a member of the hearing team to avoid an unnecessary dispute and distraction.

Roberts should limit its comments on the proposed decision to the general acceptability of the proposed decision, or to possible technical corrections. Roberts may not introduce new evidence at the SWRCB meeting. Roberts comments regarding the proposed decision must be received by the SWRCB by **12:00 noon, Friday October 11, 2002** and should be addressed to:



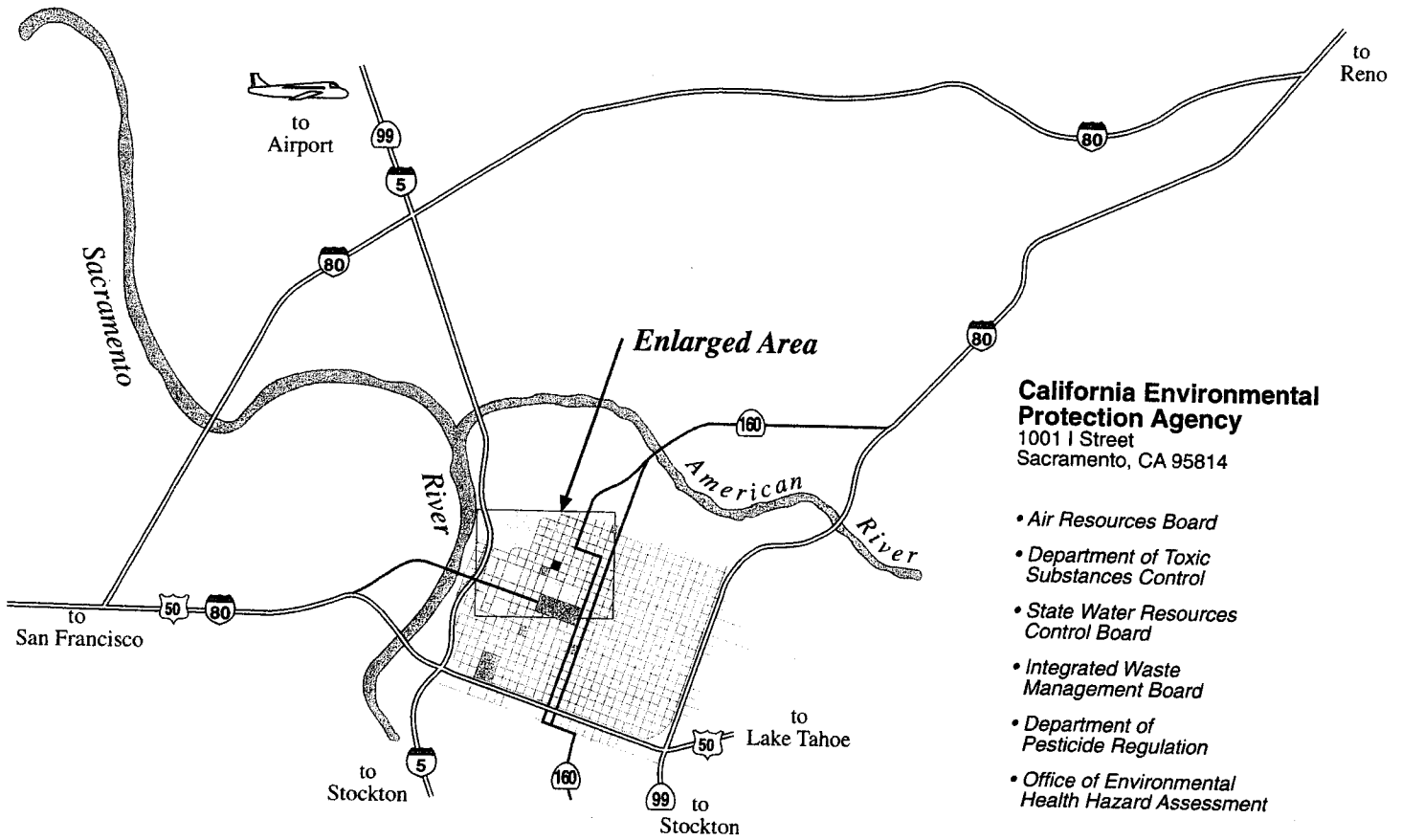

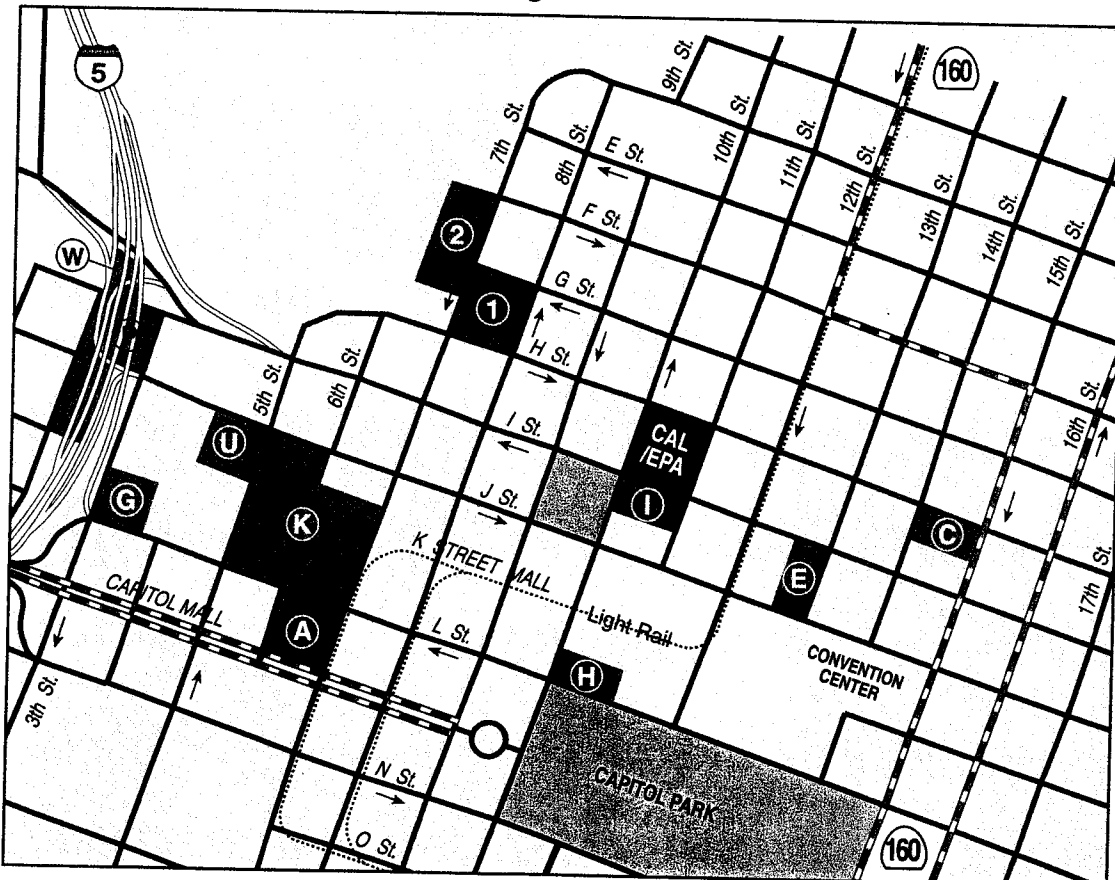
