
SANTA ANA RIVER WATER RIGHT HEARING: HEARING NOTICE ISSUES 4 AND 5 AND ORDER OF PROCEEDING

On April 5, 2007, Chino Basin Watermaster, the City of Riverside, San Bernardino Valley Municipal Water District (Muni), Western Municipal Water District of Riverside County (Western), and Orange County Water District entered into a stipulation to resolve Hearing Issues 4 and 5 on page 10 of the February 16, 2007 Notice of Public Hearing and Pre-hearing Conference on Water Right Applications and Wastewater Change Petition.

At the Pre-Hearing Status Conference, Southern California Edison (SCE) expressed concerns with Issues 4 and 5 as they relate to Applications 31165 and 31370 of Muni/Western. On April 11, 2007, Muni/Western and SCE executed a stipulation agreement to resolve SCE's concerns. The State Water Resources Control Board acknowledges receipt of the stipulation; however, it will not make a final decision on inclusion of the proposed permit term in any water right permit until an order is issued on the Santa Ana River water right applications and petition.

Enclosed is the Order of Proceedings for the Santa Ana River Hearing, as discussed at the April 20, 2007 teleconference.
