Given Mr. Wildermuth's extensive knowledge and his significant role in Watermaster's testimony, at the Pre-Hearing Conference on April 5, Watermaster will request that it be permitted 40 minutes to present Mr. Wildermuth's oral direct testimony. Even with the additional time for Mr. Wildermuth, Watermaster will still limit its overall testimony to a total of two hours.
