assign and convey to L. H. Taylor, of Reno, Nevada, all rights
now existing and to accrue under and by virtue of the following
applications to appropriate unappropriated waters of the State of
California, to wit:

Application No. 5169 for permit to store 49,000 acre-feet
of water of the Little Truckee River to be used for irrigation
and domestic purposes in Washoe County, Nevada; and

Application No. 5170 for permit to appropriate 500 cubic feet
per second of water from Truckee River and Tributaries in Nevada
County, California, for power and incidental domestic use in the
same County and State.

Both of the said applications were filed with the Division
of Water Rights, Department of Public Works of the State of
California, on August 25, 1926.
