Gentlemen: Re: Applications 5169-5170-6534.

This will acknowledge your inquiry of
January 14 concerning the above numbered applications.

The negotiations between the Nevada interests and California interests and the United States covering the matter of relative water rights and construction of works under the applications herein referred to have terminated in the approval as to form of an agreement covering all matters pertaining to the controversy.

The United States, as a party to the agreement and as the party loaning the moneys with which to construct the proposed works, has been actively engaged in the detailed topographic surveys of the reservoir site and the Bureau of Reclamation is at this time working on the plans and specifications of the works. Diamond drilling crews with full equipment for final investigation of foundation are at this time enroute to the site and will be at work within ten days.

The agreement herein mentioned has not been executed but will be immediately following elections to be held by this district and the Truckee-Carson Irrigation District, said elections covering indorsement of agreement by the district members and approval of the repayment contracts with the United States.

Inclosed is a copy of the agreement in its final form. The modifications to the temporary restraining order referred to in the agreement have not been made at this time but when this is done the modified form will be forwarded to you with the understanding that it is subject to either protest by the parties to the restraining order or further modification by the court.
