Gentlemen:

Attention Harold Conkling

Your last communication to us requests the submission of the amended form of our application No. 5170 by August 9, next. Due to the fact that we are at this time involved in a serious controversy with the United States concerning additional costs for construction of the Boca Dam and that the same is not yet completed, together with the fact that under the provisions of Article XX, of the Truckee River Agreement, a copy of which you have, control and operation of Boca Dam will not be turned over to this district until the Secretary of the Interior issues a certificate to this district that said reservoir is available for storage, we are not in a position to consummate matters with the Sierra Pacific Power Company, nor to prosecute applications with the Federal Power Commission.

In view of the conditions above mentioned, we respectfully request that we be accorded an extension of time within which to complete the amendment of application 5170 until the Operative Date of the Truckee River Agreement as such Operative Date is defined in Article XX of the Truckee River Agreement.
