Dear Mr. Franklin:

On August 23, 1944 petitions to change the re-diversion point No. 12 to the re-diversion point No. 11 were filed in connection with the above numbered applications.

The petitions indicate the intake as being N. 88° 05' W. 2620 feet from the N.W. corner of Section 20, T 19 N, R 19 E, M.D.B. & M. and being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 19, T 19 N, R 19 E, M.D.B. & M.

If the sections are regular, as is indicated on the United States-Tahoe National Forest map, it would appear that the point of re-diversion No. 11 would be within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 18, T 19 N, R 19 E, M.D.B. & M. Will you please inform this office which is correct.
