Dear Mr. Taylor:

Your letter of June 30, in connection with the permits issued in the matter of Applications 5169 and 6534, is acknowledged.

As requested a copy of the hydrograph of Boca Reservoir releases which Mr. Wheeler showed you at the time of his conference with you in Reno on May 24, 1951 is enclosed.

It will be noted from the hydrographs that maximum use, during the season of use specified under the permits, occurred in 1949 when, it appears, 29491 acre-feet can be credited as having been beneficially used within the District. This represents the maximum amount for which license could be issued, without inclusion of the Truckee-Carson Irrigation District, for the reason that the balance of the water stored in Boca Reservoir is released each winter and transferred, we understand, to Lahontan Reservoir for later use in the Truckee-Carson Irrigation District.

It is believed the above will explain the reason for the procedure suggested in our letter of June 1, 1951.
