NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO APPROPRIATE WATER

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, THAT United States -  
Department of Interior  
Bureau of Reclamation, Region IV  
P. O. Box 360  
Salt Lake City 10, Utah

has under the date of February 18, 1958 applied to the State Water Rights Board for a permit to appropriate unappropriated water, subject to vested rights.

Description of Project

Water to be appropriated from Prosser Creek tributary to Truckee River.

In the County of Nevada.

Amount applied for: 30,000 acre-feet per annum.

Diversion season named: January 1 to December 31 of each year.

Water to be used for irrigation, fish culture, flood control and recreational purposes.

Point of diversion within NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 30, T18N, R17E, MDB&M at Prosser Creek Dam.

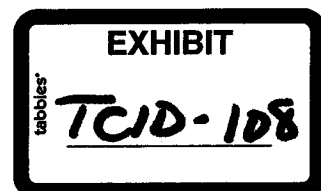
Points of rediversion: The water is released from Prosser Creek Dam to Prosser Creek and flows to the Truckee River. From the Truckee River a portion of the water is rediverted to Truckee Meadows lands at a point 1,520 feet, S8 $^{\circ}$ 33'W from NW corner Section 29, T19N, R18E, MDB&M and at a point 5,760 feet S 22 $^{\circ}$ 29'E from NE corner Section 7, T19N, R20E, MDB&M, as well as at numerous points in between. The remainder flows in the Truckee River to Derby Dam, 2,725 feet N32 $^{\circ}$ 45'E from SW corner Section 19, T20N, R23E, where it is rediverted through the Truckee Canal to Lahontan Reservoir, 3,850 feet N82 $^{\circ}$ 45'E from SW corner Section 33, T19N, R26E. It is released from Lahontan Reservoir into the Carson River and rediverted to the Newlands Project lands at Carson Diversion Dam, 1,885 feet N56 $^{\circ}$ 30'W from SE corner Section 19, T19N, R27E, and at Sagouspe Diversion Dam, 3,620 feet N43 $^{\circ}$ 00'E, from SW corner Section 4, T19N, R29E, as well as at numerous points in between.

Place of use described: Water to be used within Truckee Meadows having a gross acreage of 36,340 and a net irrigable acreage of 26,800 acres being within T18N to T20N, R18E to R21E, MDB&M; and Newlands Project having a gross acreage of 107,140 acres and a net irrigable acreage of 70,000 acres within T17N to T20N, R24E to R31E, MDB&M, as shown on map filed with State Water Rights Board.

Relative to Protests

Blanks upon which to submit protests will be supplied free upon request.

Any person desiring to protest against the granting of such permit shall within 60 days from date hereof file with the State Water Rights Board, Sacramento, California, a written protest. Such protest shall clearly set forth the protestant's objections to the approval of the application and shall contain the following information:
