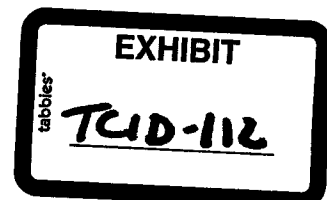

RESOLUTION OF CALIFORNIA-NEVADA INTERSTATE
COMPACT COMMISSION RE TERMS AND CONDITIONS
IN PROSSER RESERVOIR PERMITS

WHEREAS, The Joint California-Nevada Interstate Compact Commission has adopted and approved certain conditions to be recommended to the California State Water Rights Board relative to the Prosser Reservoir Application No. 18006 of the United States of America, Bureau of Reclamation;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Joint California-Nevada Interstate Compact Commission respectfully recommends to the California State Water Rights Board that any permit or permits which said Board may grant with respect to Application No. 18006 of the United States of America, Bureau of Reclamation, be made expressly subject to the following terms and conditions:

② 1. In providing for fish culture pursuant to this permit, the permittee shall operate Prosser Creek Reservoir in coordination with releases of water from Lake Tahoe into the Truckee River in accordance with the operation schedule contained in U. S. Bureau of Reclamation, Prosser Creek Reservoir Operation Study, January 14, 1958, ^{and amended July 1, 1958,} on file with this Board, or in accordance with any modified operation schedule that may be submitted by the permittee, and approved by this Board after notice and opportunity to be heard has been given to all parties and other interested persons in this proceeding. The Board retains jurisdiction of this permit for the purpose of considering and approving any such modified operation schedule.

2. The appropriative rights acquired under this permit are subject to the rights reserved to California water users to appropriate waters of the Truckee River System as set forth in permits heretofore issued to the United States of America, Bureau of Reclamation, pursuant to its Applications Nos. 15672 and 15673 for the Stampede Reservoir.

Special

④ 3. If and when an interstate compact covering the distribution and use of the waters of the Truckee and Carson Rivers is approved by the Legislatures of the States of California and Nevada and is consented to by Congress, the operation of Prosser Reservoir shall be in conformance with such compact and the terms and conditions set forth in this permit which are in conflict thereto shall not apply; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Joint California-Nevada Interstate Compact Commission recommends that, subject to the foregoing terms and conditions, a permit be granted to the United States of America, Bureau of Reclamation, with respect to Application No. 18006.
