- reorganizing for clarity "Effects on adding places and purposes of use"
- adding a few points to "The effect of the project on public trust resources and protection of those resources where feasible"

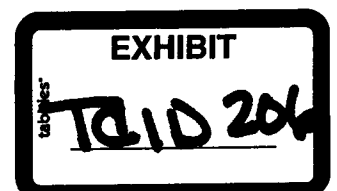

As discussed on the phone on Friday, I've attached for your review our most recent version (7-2-07) of the TROA Admin FEIS/EIR writeup on the WATER RIGHT PETITIONS AND APPLICATIONS. We (USBR and CA) did our best to respond to the Board's comments and produce a useful document, but we're still uncertain if we've included sufficient information and explained understandably how TROA fits into CA's water right process.

As you foretold, we're a day late in getting this to you, since we couldn't finish it over the weekend as I'd hoped. However, I'd like to discuss this with you and/or Susan later this week, if at all possible. I'm available just about any time after 10:30 today (7-3-07), but, of course, not tomorrow.
