The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, by and through its attorneys undersigned, without submitting to the jurisdiction of the State Engineer of Nevada, and without acknowledging authority of the State Engineer of Nevada to allocate waters of the Little Truckee River, hereby protests Applications #24310, #24311, and #24312 filed by the United States Bureau of Reclamation of Sacramento, California for permission to appropriate and divert waters of the Little Truckee River.

The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe alleges that there is no unappropriated water in the Little Truckee River, the Truckee River or any of their tributaries, the paramount right to and interest in all of such water being held by and vested in the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe.

The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe further alleges that the appropriations requested in the aforesaid applications would impair the prior existing rights of this Tribe in and to the waters of the Little Truckee River and the Truckee River, and
