

COMMENT LETTER-3/18/08 BOARD MEETING, ITEM 8, CONSIDERATION OF A PROPOSED ORDER IN WHICH THE STATE WATER BOARD ISSUES A CEASE AND DESIST ORDER AND ASSESSES AN ADMINISTRATIVE CIVIL LIABILTY AGAINST THE VINEYARD CLUB, INC., FOR THE UNAUTHORIZED DIVERSION OF WATER IN SONOMA COUNTY

The Division of Water Rights Prosecution Team (Prosecution Team) supports the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) draft order released February 20, 2008, issuing a cease and desist order and assessing administrative civil liability in the amount of \$14,750.

The Prosecution Team particularly wishes to express vigorous support for the State Water Board's determination in section 8.2.1 of the draft order that "violation of Standard Term 62 constitutes a trespass violation within the meaning of section 1052." This determination comports with the intent of the Water Code and is absolutely essential to continued effective enforcement of water rights by the Division.

While the Prosecution Team maintains that, under the facts of this case, administrative civil liability in the amount of \$30,000 would have been warranted, the Prosecution Team supports the State Water Board's decision to impose liability in the amount of \$14,750 and does not intend to contest that determination.

The Enforcement Team requests only one minor change, to correct an erroneous date in the draft order. Lines 5-6 of paragraph 8.2.2 on page 11 read, "Mr. Sandell testified that he removed the pipeline on May 29, 2007." The date should be corrected to read May 29, 2005.
