MOCHESENEY, T.C. # WATER APPROPRIATION NOTICE.

(Water Appro. Notice) # I, T.C. McChesney, a citizen of the United States and resi-  
##### dent of San Jose, California, do hereby give notice that I locate, ap-  
propriate and claim the flood, freshet, and all other waters flowing down the stream and past the  
point where this notice is posted which is on the left bank of the San Joaquin River at its point  
of intersection with the Santa Reclamation District Levee and is approximately N 21 1/2° E 4900 feet  
from the corner of Sections 3 and 4, 33 and 34 Tps. 2 and 3 S., R 6 E., M.D.M., to the extent of 200  
cubic feet per second or 10000 Miners inches measured under a four inch pressure.

I intend to divert said waters by means of a ditch having a bottom width of 18 feet  
and of sufficient depth to carry said amount of water and also by means of pumps of sufficient size  
to lift said amount of water.

I intend to use said waters for irrigation, domestic power, and all other applied  
uses on the westerly side of the San Joaquin Valley in San Joaquin and other Counties of California.

WITNESSETH: That Whereas, the parties hereto for a long time past have been and now are  
husband and wife: and

Whereas, the parties hereto for some time past have been and now are living separate and  
apart; and

Whereas, differences have arisen between the parties hereto and for the purpose of for-  
ever settling all property interests between the parties hereto;

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises and also in consideration of the sum  
of One Hundred and Twenty-five (\$125.00) Dollars paid by the party of the second part to the party  
of the first part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, by the party of the first part, the  
party of the first part forever releases and acquits the party of the second part from all claims  
or demands that she, the party of the first part, ever had or now has against said party of the  
second part for or on account of community property, or separate property, and against any and all  
property of whatsoever nature or kind, or against the party of the second part that she may or might  
have by reason of being the wife of the said W H Knowles, party of the second part, from the begin-  
ning of the world, at this time, and in the future, forever; and that the party of the first part  
hereby acknowledged full and complete satisfaction forever of all claims and demands, of whatsoever  
nature or kind, that she may or might now have against said party of the second part for or on ac-  
count of any and all reasons whatsoever.
