Subject: AB2121

I am writing as a resident of the Sea Ranch (CA 95497). This proposed regulation will devastate my community's water supply, and I am very hopeful that the comment period can be extended, preferably by 90 days, so that communities affected will have time to work with the Water Board to ameliorate its impact. AB2121 will make it impossible for those who live at Sea Ranch to reside here year round and real estate people in the area have already realized that they need to disclose the prospect of the reduced water supply. They have also realized that they will, as a consequence, sell no properties in our area. (AB2121 also impacts the water supply of the town of Gualala, just north of Sea Ranch). Our Volunteer Fire Dept. will not have the water supply it needs to fight the inevitable fires, etc.

To keep this comment short, I will only add that I do think that we can improve on water conservation and hope that an extended comment period can be used to explore other means to achieve some of the ends of AB2121.
