1 am writing this letter to ask you to consider the impact of proposed polices regarding AB 2121 on sea coast communities in Sonoma County. My understanding is that the Board is considering adopting a policy intended to enhance instream flows in the north coast region, which includes the Gualala River. This policy as presented could have drastic effects on the communities in the area by drastically reducing or eliminating their water supply especially in drought conditions.

We receive our water from aquifers feeding the Gualala River. Our water company is very careful about preserving the flows in the Gualala River so that there is minimal impact to the environment.
