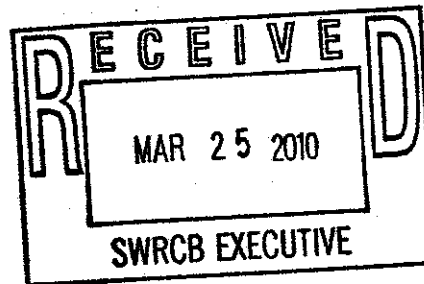

Re: COMMENT LETTER--AB2121 POLICY

State Water Resources Control Board:

My wife and I are alarmed to read about the SWRCB staff recommendations for AB2121 that could lead to a possible serious reduction of water supply to our home in The Sea Ranch. We urge you to not approve the policy as written. Please amend it to take into account the economic and human burdens it would cause.

The potential impact to the long established communities of The Sea Ranch and Gualala could be devastating. Our thriving communities would be seriously jeopardized-- unemployment and exodus, businesses closed, property values plummeting, and tax revenues shrinking by the millions of dollars.

We are also concerned that the science being applied to our specific river, the South Fork Gualala River, is faulty and not pertinent to its specific situation.

We urge you to not adopt AB2121 in its present form.
