I am a homeowner at The Sea Ranch, a planned unit development. I am concerned that the policy proposed by the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) staff in response to AB2121 would have drastic negative impacts on The Sea Ranch water supply. It may leave The Sea Ranch without water supply for days or even months each year. The Sea Ranch needs to have an adequate water supply to sustain the community's viability. The Sea Ranch has an excellent water conservation program and a very low gallons per capita per day usage. The opportunity for additional conservation is limited.

I request that the SWRCB and staff make every effort possible to assure that The Sea Ranch will not be without adequate water to sustain our community.
