Notice of Wastewater Change Petition WW0111

COUNTY: Yolo

STREAM SYSTEM: Willow Slough Bypass
tributary to the Lower Sacramento River

The City of Davis (Petitioner) has filed a wastewater change petition with the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Water Rights (Division) pursuant to California Water Code section 1211. The Petitioner requests authorization to reduce the discharge of treated wastewater to Willow Slough Bypass by approximately 1.8 million gallons per day (mgd) (2,016 acre-feet per year (AFY)) from the Petitioner's Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) during all months of the year.
