Notice of Minor Change to Water Right Application A030259

A minor change has been initiated under Water Code section 1700.4 to make minor changes to water right application A030259 of Fahri Diner and Grapevine Holdings L-1, LLC. The project associated with the application and minor change is in Sonoma County and would divert water from the Gird Creek stream system.

Summary of Water Right Application A030259

Date of Filing: The application was filed with the State Water Board on June 10, 1993.

Source of Water: The source of water is an Unnamed Stream tributary to Gird Creek thence the Russian River.

Season of Diversion: The season for diversion of water is from November 1 of each year through April 30 of the succeeding year.

Diversion Method and Amount: Water will be diverted by collection to onstream storage and will be limited to 42 acre-feet per year.

Points of Diversion: Water will be diverted from two points:

- Point 1 is an onstream reservoir (Vineyard Reservoir) with a capacity of 20 acre-feet located within the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of projected Section 23, Township 10 North, Range 9 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
- Point 2 is an onstream reservoir (Livestock Reservoir) with a capacity of 2 acre-feet located within the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of projected Section 23, Township 10 North, Range 9 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Purposes of Use: The purposes of use for water are irrigation, frost protection, stockwatering, and recreational.

Place of Use: The place of use for irrigation and frost protection is 40 acres as follows:

- 10 acres within the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter;
- 30 acres within the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter;
- All within projected Section 23, Township 10 North, Range 9 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

The place of use for stockwatering and recreational is at the two onstream reservoirs at Points 1 and 2.

Summary of Minor Change

Source of Water: The source of water has not changed.

Season of Diversion: The season for diversion of water has changed to December 15 of each year through March 31 of the succeeding year.

Diversion Method and Amount: The maximum amount of water requested for diversion by collection to onstream storage has been changed to 16.3 acre-feet per year.

Points of Diversion: The points where water will be diverted have been changed by reducing the capacity of Point 1 (Vineyard Reservoir) to 16.3 acre-feet and removing Point 2 (Livestock Reservoir).

Purposes of Use: The purposes of use for water have not changed.

Place of Use: The place of use for irrigation and frost protection has been reduced to 37 acres as follows:

- 6 acres within the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter;
- 29 acres within the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter;
- 1 acre within the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter;
- 1 acre within the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter
- All within projected Section 23, Township 10 North, Range 9 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

The place of use for stockwatering and recreational has been reduced to the onstream reservoir at Point 1 (Vineyard Reservoir).
