### NOTICE OF MINOR CHANGE REQUEST FOR WW0111 ORDER

COUNTY: Yolo

Watercourses: Willow Slough Bypass and  
Conaway Drain

The City of Davis (City) has filed a request for minor change (Minor Change) to the WW0111 Order under Water Code section 1700.6, with the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Water Rights (Division). The City proposes to expand the Place of Use (POU) per the WW0111 Order approved in 2023. The Minor Change will add 13,174 acres to the authorized 7,627 acres of POU. The additional POU could use up to the entire amount of recycled water, up to 2,016 acre-feet per year (afy), authorized per the WW0111 Order. If this occurred, the previously authorized POU would use none of the recycled water. There will not be any further reduction in discharge from the City's wastewater treatment plant to the Willow Slough Bypass and Conaway Drain, which will remain limited to 2,016 afy for the entire POU, which includes the authorized 7,627 acres plus the additional 13,174 acres. Therefore, the Minor Change should not cause any adverse impact to the water supply of other legal users of water or instream beneficial uses. There will be no change in the authorized purposes of use of irrigation, industrial, and municipal since the specific purpose of use in the additional POU will be irrigation. In addition, the runoff from the treated wastewater used for irrigation in the additional POU will return to the Yolo Bypass, thereby remaining in the same hydrologic region of its origin. No new or adapted facilities are needed to facilitate this change.
