PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The California Department of Water Resources (DWR) has applied for water quality certification to install (as early as April 1, 2016) and remove (by November 30, 2016) a single salinity barrier at West False River to control saltwater intrusion into the Delta and conserve water in upstream reservoirs for other uses. The salinity barrier will only be constructed if DWR, in co-operation with other State and federal agencies, determines that a drought has reduced water storage in the State Water Project to critical levels.
