A request for a water quality certification (certification) under section 401 of the Clean Water Act for the following project was filed with the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board). **PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** On January 8, 2024, the United States Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation) submitted a certification application for the Battle Creek Salmon and Steelhead Restoration Project: Phase 2 No Regrets. Reclamation applied to the United States Army Corps of Engineers for nationwide permits 27 and 33 to remove the following facilities from South Fork Battle Creek and its tributaries: South Diversion Dam, South Canal, Soap Creek Feeder Diversion Dam, Lower Ripley Creek Feeder Diversion Dam, and Coleman Diversion Dam. These facilities are part of the Pacific Gas and Electric Company's Battle Creek Hydroelectric Project (Federal Energy Regulatory Commission No. 1121).
