Re: National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's National Marine Fisheries Service's Support for State Water Resources Control Board's Draft Order WR 2011-00XX regarding the State Water Resources Control Board's Investigation Order WR 2011-003-EXEC and Merced Irrigation District's Petition in relation to the Merced River Hydroelectric Project, Federal Energy Regulatory Commission Project No. P-2179, on Merced River, California

Dear Clerk of the Board and Secretary Bose:

The National Marine Fisheries Service (NMF) of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration supports State Water Resources Control Board's Draft Order WR 2011-00XX, issued April 6, 2011, regarding the State Water Resources Control Board's Investigation Order WR 2011-003-EXEC and denying Merced Irrigation District's (MID) Petition for Stay. The SWRCB's Investigation Order WR 2011-003-EXEC, issued January 28, 2011, ordered studies to be done by MID (Applicant) for the Merced River Hydroelectric Project, Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC or Commission) Project No. P-2179 (Project), on Merced River, California.

NMFS also supports the proposed Technical Workshop, but we believe that the legal issues should be resolved first in a Board Hearing. In addition, NMFS would like to request a time extension for additional comments on both SWRCB Orders and the Technical Workshop or Board Hearing through April 19, 2011.

NMFS, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, and California Department of Fish and Game (CDFG) were among many Federal, State, and conservation groups (CG) that recently filed comments, proposed studies, and information requests for the Project regarding the Applicant's Initial Study Report for the Project, pursuant to the Federal Power Act (FPA) (NMFS 2011).



NMFS' information requests were very similar to those requests made by the CDFG, CGs, and State Water Board in its Order WR 2011-003-EXEC. Order WR 2011-003-EXEC and Draft Order WR 2011-00XX provide additional emphasis as to the importance of gathering adequate information during the FPA licensing process that could be utilized by all relevant Federal and State agencies. NMFS agrees with the logic expressed in the letters of support for Order WR 2011-003-EXEC submitted by CDFG and CG regarding the need for study information regarding the Project's effects on all resources in the Merced River, including anadromous fish resources (CDFG 2011; CG 2011).

NMFS will utilize appropriate study information to further our Resource Goals and Objectives for the Merced River (NMFS 2009) that may be affected by the Project. NMFS will also utilize appropriate study information in making decisions and recommendations and conducting consultations under applicable authorities during the course of these FPA proceedings, including:

- NMFS' decisions under FPA Section 18 authority to prescribe fishways (16 U.S.C. §811);
- NMFS' recommendations under FPA Sections 10(a) and 10(j) for conditions for the protection, mitigation, and enhancement of anadromous fish, including their spawning grounds and habitat (16 U.S.C. §803);
- NMFS' recommendations pursuant to the Fish and Wildlife Coordination Act (16 U.S.C. 661 et seq.);
- The Commission's Essential Fish Habitat Consultation with NMFS, pursuant to the Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conservation and Management Act (16 U.S.C. §1801 et seq.); and
- The Commission's Endangered Species Act Section 7 Consultation with NMFS, pursuant to 16 U.S.C. §§ 1531 et seq.
