Dear Ms. Kyler:

We own a cabin in Pinecrest and understand that PG&E is asking to drain the lake to levels lower than previous years. We use our cabin all year round, especially during Labor Day and all through the fall. We swim and boat in the lake and would like it to remain as full as possible until at least October 1st. It is disappointing to drive up to our cabin and find the lake level dropping in September! We do not like to see the exposed beaches, rocks and trees and they make it difficult to swim and boat. We also noticed that the buoys in the swimming area are broken and should be fixed.

We, and many other cabin owners, recreate after Labor Day in Pinecrest and bring needed business to the area. Please consider holding the lake elevation to 5608' at Labor Day and start unrestricted lowering of the lake October 1st.
