Re: Sept 29 2011 Revised Notice Spring-Gap Stanislaus Hydroelectric Project-Pinecrest Reservoir Minimum Lake-Level

Dear Ms. Kyler:

We understand that PG&E is going to request that the Pinecrest lake level at Labor Day be lowered to 5600-5605 feet. At 5602 feet, the Marina's gas pump is unusable. Currently PG&E is held to a lake level of 5608-5610 at Labor Day. Many people use the lake area after Labor Day and any lowering of the lake should be on October 1, rather than Labor Day. So we would like to see the lake level remain at the 5608-5610 until October 1.

We also feel that the upper fishing pier should be removed, along with the lower pier and walkway, and be replaced with a floating, ADA compliant pier in another location.
