Sir, to allow the installation of a "Thermal Curtain" in Lake Almanor would negatively affect the ecology of the Lake and thus, do great harm to the fish in the Lake. It is quite obvious that very little scientific research has been done to clearly indicate the efficacy of pulling cold water from the Lake to "lower" temperatures downstream. Based on the information presented by Dr. Johnston's evaluation, there is little scientific evidence to suggest there would be any positive outcome to installing the "curtain" in the Lake. To allow such a radical experiment without adequate research is nothing less than irresponsible.

I therefore, respectfully request that no action be taken without some extended scientific evidence to clearly show whether such a move is justified.
