As a long time visitor to Lake Almanor I am appalled by the proposed Alternatives 1 and 2 as described in the Draft EIR. Lake Almanor is not only a destination to one of the most pristine areas of California but it is also home to thousands of people who depend on the lake for their livelihood.

The project goal is based on a 37 year old cold water fishery designation under which PG & E is required to take reasonable steps to cool temperatures to improve fish habitat to renew their license. Building a thermal curtain is not reasonable and warming water in one area to cool water in another is ludicrous. The curtain itself will be unsightly and the cost for it will be at the peoples expense.

Too much time and money has gone into this already. Its time to stop this mandated bureaucratic nonsense and move on to more important issues.

I doubt whether the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission wants to be responsible for the collapse of a community. Furthermore it is likely that if this moves forward there will be consequences beyond what can be imagined. That is normally the case when man messes with nature.
