Mr. Barnes,

After spending some time reviewing the draft EIR regarding the proposed "Thermal Curtains" at Lake Almanor, I was expecting to become more informed of the merits of this project. Unfortunately the opposite occurred. This study is far too focused on overly-simplified issues and does not address those issues of potential greatest impact AT ALL. Economic concerns were not addressed adequately nor was a sophisticated (or even basic) argument made to convince the population of the region of any greater good achieved by this project. The later point is an imperative and I was hoping to find many good points in favor of what I thought would be a beneficial plan to improve the cold water fisheries of the Feather River. Instead I was left feeling that this project would bring marginal (if any) significant improvement to the river. Until the SWRCB develops a program with more promise and compelling evidence to back it up, I am against moving forward with this plan as submitted.

I am opposed to the "Thermal Curtains" as proposed.
