The Carmel River Steelhead Association has problems with the WR 2009-0060 Condition 2 ideas of modification sent to you by the Monterey Peninsula Water Management District.

- 1: CRSA does not believe the MPWMD suggestions simplify Condition 2 but make it easier for people to find a way around condition 2.
- 2: CRSA believes that no one should be able to use water consumption data before the date WO 2009-0060 was issued to determine the amount of water used by a given piece of property.
- 3: CRSA believes than no water allowances should be able to be transferred from one property to another.
- 4: CRSA believes WO 2009-0060 was meant to punish the residents and businesses of the peninsula and allowing a path around condition 2 is contrary to that purpose.
- 5: CRSA believes if the community would have complied with WO2009-0060 and secured a new water supply by the date specified in WO 2009-0060 we would not be in this position now.
- 6: CRSA believes the State Board by extending WO 2009-0060 has already accommodated the peninsula.
