Hi,

MPWMD staff met with State Water Board staff this week to try to get a better interpretation of Condition 2 of the Cease and Desist Order (CDO). Condition 2 identifies which projects are subject to

the CDO. The Water Board staff requested the following information. We need your help, as each Jurisdiction is the gatekeeper of its Allocations:

- What projects are on your Jurisdiction's "water waiting list"? Please provide us with a copy of your list. Identify the property (address and APN), the project description (is it a remodel or a new structure/connection and is it commercial or residential), and the quantity of water requested.
- 2. If your Jurisdiction has water in an Allocation that is still available and that is being selectively released, what is your Jurisdiction's criteria for determining which projects will receive water?
- 3. Which projects in your Jurisdiction have received a Water Release Form that authorized water from your Jurisdiction's Paralta or Pre-Paralta Allocations (and Water West and Quail Meadows in the County) that have not yet acquired their Water Permit? (The current Allocation balances are toward the end of this email):
  - Please identify the nature of the project (new connection, remodel/addition, residential or non-residential) and the amount of water released. If you have a list of <u>all</u> Water Releases for these Allocations by APN issued by your Jurisdiction since 1993 (and the date the form was signed), the District can help you look up whether a permit has been issued and how much water was used. (It is possible that your Jurisdiction may have more water available than you thought if the amount of water used was less than you released.)

Time is of the essence. Please provide this information to the District as soon as possible. We would like to get a response back to the Water Board before January 3rd.

If you have questions, please email me. Likewise, if you need help with conveying the urgency of this project to your management, let me know and the District can assist. I will be out of the office until the 27<sup>th</sup>, but I can respond to email. I will not have a phone available. Dave Stoldt will be in the office during that time.
